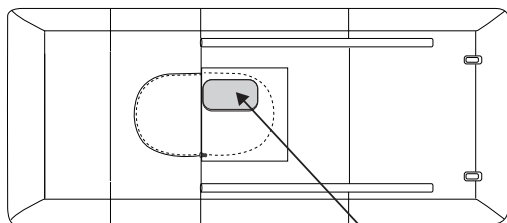
The headrest pillow is placed at the bottom of the chaise longue carton. Take it out and zip up the zipper between headrest and chaise longue. Headrest pillow can be magnetically attached to the chaise.



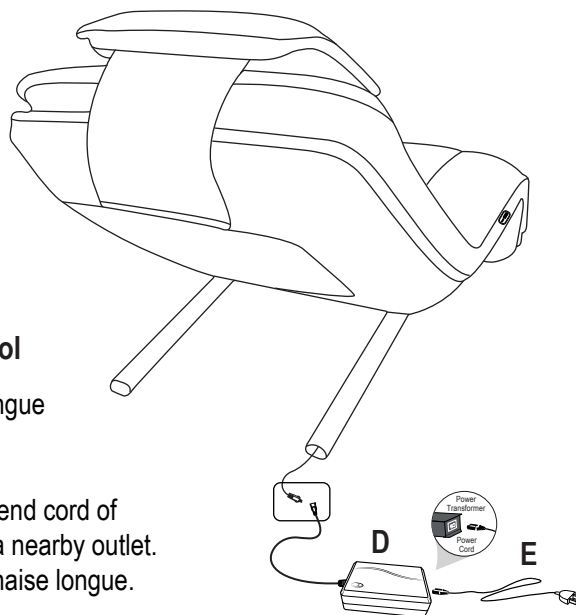
The remote control can be magnetically attached to the chaise longue.

ROOMS TO GO ► Operating Instructions for Chaise Longue

The power cord, transformer and the remote control can be found by following the red ribbon at the bottom of the chaise longue. Pull the bottom zipper to remove and set aside to be used later.

Do not plug the power cord into a power outlet until your chaise longue is fully assembled and in place.

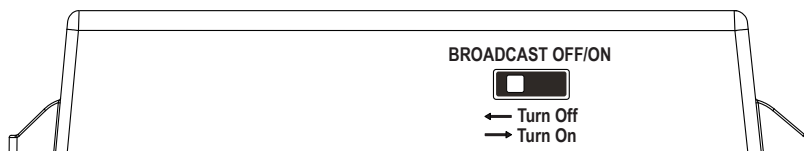
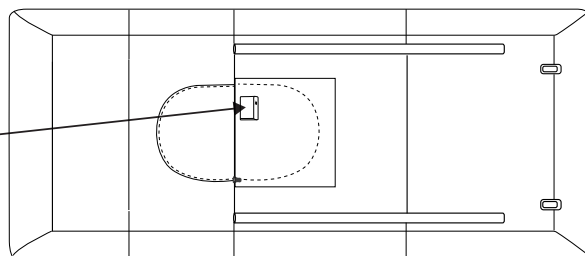
- 1) To help prevent shock and or damage to your product, plug the end cord of transformer into the chaise longue, then plug the transformer into a nearby outlet.
- 2) Read the operating instructions carefully before operating the chaise longue.

IMPORTANT NOTE

- Do Not plug the power cord into a power outlet until your furniture is fully assembled and in place.
- To help prevent shock and or damage to your product only plug the power cord into a grounded outlet.
- To avoid any risk of suffocation to children or pets, dispose of all plastic bags immediately.
- To ensure proper performance, occasionally check for loose screws and tighten as needed.
- Unplug unit from power source prior to cleaning mechanism.
- Do not allow electrical components to come in contact with any liquids.
- Do not continuously operate mechanism for more than one minute or you may go into protection mode by shutting down to prevent overheating.

Multimedia Control Box

The Multimedia Control Box at the bottom of the chaise longue. Pull the bottom zipper to use it.



How to Connect Wireless

When using the audio system, first turn on the power of the chaise longue, then search for the wireless connection named "MOTO Audio" with your mobile phone, tap to pair, and the connection will prompt "Connected" if the connection is successful. If you want to stop pairing, turn off the wireless connection, then will prompt "Disconnected".

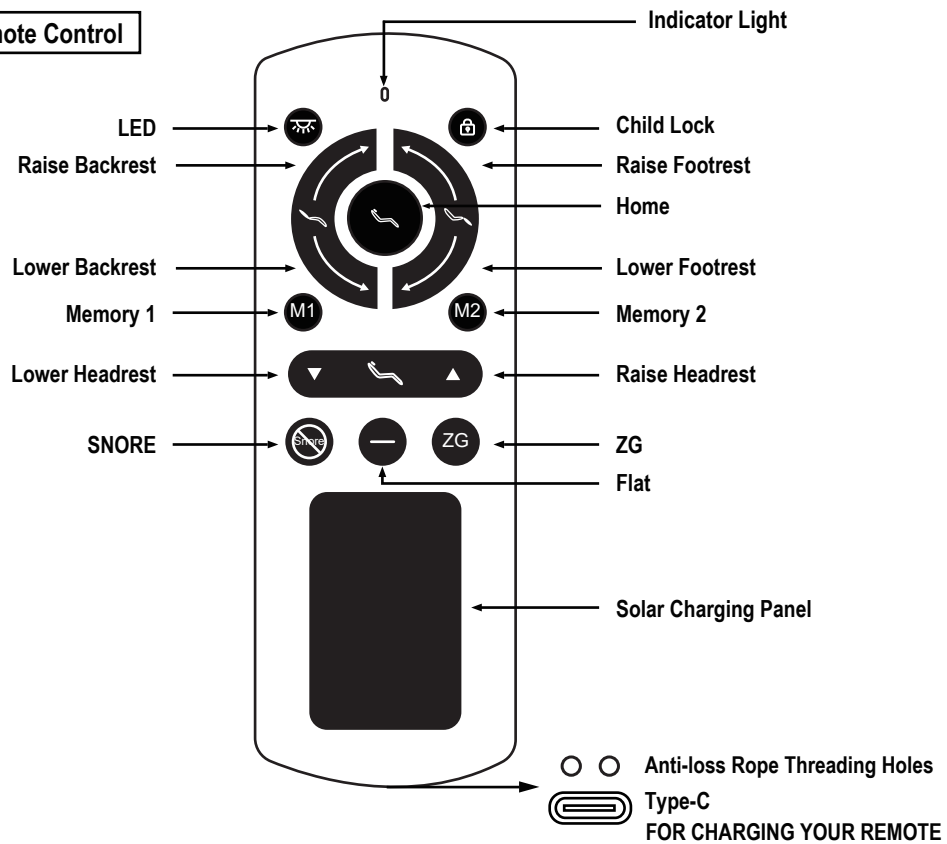
Using Broadcast Mode

Broadcast mode is on by default, chaise longue A will act as the signal source, and chaise longue B will sync to play the audio or video from chaise longue A. If you want to turn off the broadcast mode, Toggle the lever at the bottom of the chaise longue to turn it off, then hear the prompt "broadcast off".

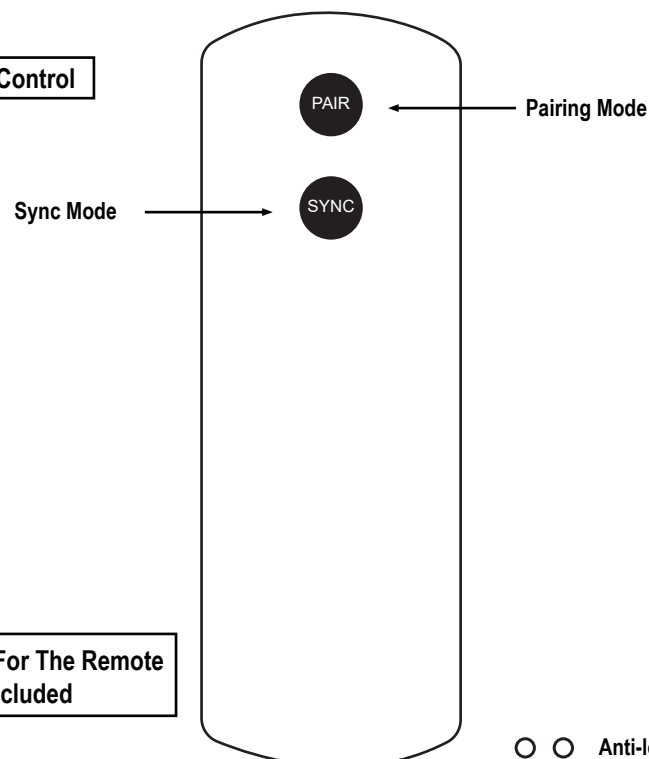

Operating Instructions for Chaise Longue

HOW TO PAIR THE CHAISE WITH THE REMOTE CONTROL

First power off the chaise, then press and hold the "PAIR" button on the back of the remote control at the same time until the indicator light dims, indicating that the remote control has entered the pairing state, and then reconnect the chaise to the power, and when the indicator light brightens, it means that the chaise and the remote control are successfully paired.

HOW TO RESET THE CONTROL BOX CALIBRATION

If you have purchased a chaise longue, Firstly, reset the Control Box Calibration, press any key to raise or lower the chaise longue, then hold down both "Lower Headrest" and "Raise Headrest" simultaneously, and wait for all motors to stop working, the control box will be reset and calibrated successfully. Please note that if you have changed control box or remote control, you must reset the control box calibration. If you don't perform the above operations, the chaise longue may not be able to accurately use each function.

HOW TO ADJUST THE CHAISE LONGUE, HEADREST

Sit on the furniture, press the button of the remote control, and use it to raise or lower the Backrest/Footrest/Headrest. Press the HOME button to return to the chaise initial state, as shown in the illustration on the remote control. If you want to use the "Raise Footrest" function in the "HOME" button state, please hold the "Raise Footrest" button, and the chaise longue footrest will be first flattened and then raised.

HOW TO USE CHILD LOCK

Press and hold the Child Lock button, then all buttons will be locked when the indicator flashes. (After locking, pressing any button will make the indicator flash for about 15 seconds.) Press and hold the Child Lock button again, and the lock will be released when the indicator stays on. (After unlocking, pressing any button will make the indicator flash for about 3 seconds and then turn off.)

HOW TO USE LED

Press the "LED" button to turn on/off the lights under the chaise are shining blue.

HOW TO USE SYNC FUNCTION

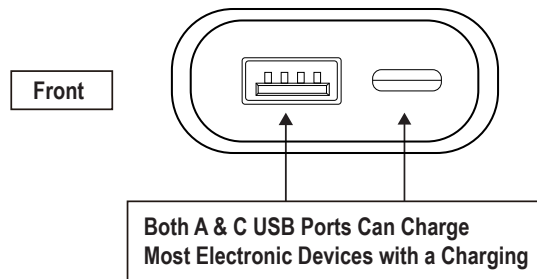
If you have purchased two or more multimedia furniture, please first press the "Raise Backrest" and "Raise Footrest" buttons, operate each remote control one by one, and the synchronization will be successful when the lights are turned off and the lights flash again. After the synchronization is successful, if you want to unsynchronize, press and hold the "SYNC" button on the back of the remote control to unsynchronize it, and again press and hold to restore the sync function. After the first synchronization is complete, remote A and remote B can both control chaise longue A and chaise longue B simultaneously. When you press and hold the sync button on remote A, it changes to only control chaise longue A. At this time, remote B can still control both chaises. Then, if you press and hold the sync button on remote A again, it will be able to control both chaises again.

HOW TO USE MEMORY FUNCTION

Press and hold the LED button, then press M1 or M2 after the indicator flashes, and when the indicator light is on, indicating that the current position has been memorized. If you want to memorize the current position to the SNORE or FLAT or ZG button, Press and hold the LED button, then press SNORE or FLAT or ZG after the indicator flashes, and when the indicator light is on, indicating that the current position has been memorized. To go to a preset SNORE or FLAT or ZG position, press and hold the desired memory button SNORE or FLAT or ZG. Please note that the SNORE or FLAT or ZG buttons initially stores a default preset comfortable position set by the chaise longue. If you have changed the default preset comfortable position of SNORE or FLAT or ZG as needed, the original position will not be restored.

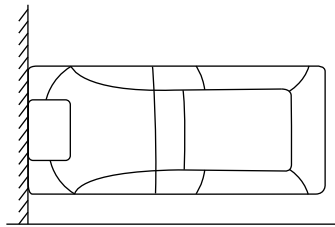
HOW TO CHARGE THE REMOTE CONTROL

Located at the bottom of the remote control is a "C" USB port. This is used to charge the remote control. When you press any key, the light doesn't come on, which means your remote needs to be charged, use a suitable charger or USB port to charge the remote. When you connect the power supply to the remote, the indicator will start flashing blue, which indicates that your remote is charging. When the remote is fully charged, the indicator will stop flashing but will remain solid until the power supply is removed. When the remote is completely depleted or fully charged, the estimated charging time is 3 hours. When the remote control is not in use, place it under the natural light, and the Solar Charging Panel can charge the remote control.

Maintain minimum of 0" space
between the furniture backs and wall.

CARE AND CLEANING

- *Upholstered furniture is packaged tightly to protect it during transit. This packaging can sometimes cause creases or misshaped cushions when the furniture comes out of the packaging. These issues will correct themselves over time as the fibers of the cushions are exposed to air. However, shaping the cushions with your hands can alleviate the creases and compressed fibers more quickly.
- *Dust often and use a vacuum cleaner to remove debris from seams and crevasses.
- *Use a soft damp cloth to gently clean soiled areas and wipe clean. Do not rub.
- *Do not use household cleaners or solvents. Such cleaners may cause damage and/or discoloration.
- *Do regularly use dedicated leather care product onto the leather furniture to prevent built up of body oils.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
No Power	Check the power transformer connection.
No Reclining	Check if the remote control is calibrated with the control box.
The Wireless Not Working	Check if the multimedia control box is turned on. Check if the wireless connection name is "MOTO Audio".
The Remote Doesn't Work	Check if the remote control has power Check if the pairing is well
