





General Assembly Guidelines


- I. Ensure that all parts and hardware are available before beginning assembly.
- II. Follow each step carefully to ensure the proper assembly of this product.
- III. Two people are recommended for ease in the assembly of this product.
- IV. The three main types of hardware used to assemble this product are wood dowels, screws and bolts.
- V. A Phillips head screwdriver is required for the assembly of this product.



- VI. Power tools should not be used to assemble this product.









Insert Wooden dowel (A) into part (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7), (8), (10) and (11).

Step 2




Secure part (6) to part (2) and (3) with screw (B).

Step 5




Secure part (7) to part (5) with screw (C).

Step 6




Secure part (4) to part (8) with screw (C).

Step 7




Secure part (3) to part (7), (8) with screw (B).

Step 8




Secure part (2) to part (7) and (8) with screw (B).

Step 9




Secure part (1) to part (2), (3) and (4) with screw (B).




Secure part (1) to part (2) and (3) with screw (D)+(G).
Insert hardware (M) to part (2) and (3)




Secure back panel (14) with nails (H).





Insert Wooden dowel (A) into part (6) and (15).


Secure part (10), (11) in drawer front part (9) with screw (B).


Insert part (12) to part (10) and (11).






WARNING

Serious or fatal injuries can occur from furniture tipping over. To prevent the furniture from tipping over we recommend that it is permanently fixed to the wall.

Wall anchor and hardware are included with this product. Please make sure hardware is suitable for your walls before installing, as different wall materials may require different types of anchors.


Attach screw (B) into washer (K), securing wall anchor (L) at the top middle part 1.

Drill your wall with a 6mm drill (not included) and insert hardware (L), securing wall anchor (J) gift washer (K) and screw (B) in the wall.




Insert part (9).

Insert Wooden dowel (A) into part (10) and (11).



Name and address information for the manufacturer responsible for the anti-tip hardware and date of production can be found on the label on the back of the furniture.

Maintenance Guide

To maintain long term performance and easy gliding of your solid wood drawers, we recommend applying wax to the wooden guide rails.

1. Bee's wax is recommended or Paraffin wax from a standard candle can be used.
2. Apply the wax by rubbing it on the wooden guide rails where there is wood-on-wood contact when opening and closing the drawer. (Wax should be room temperature, do not melt the wax onto the wood)
3. Wax should be applied every few months for the first year and then only when needed after that to keep the drawers sliding smoothly.
