



#### **General Assembly Guidelines**


- 1. Ensure that all parts and hardware are available before beginning assembly.
- || Follow each step carefully to ensure the proper assembly of this product.
- III. Two people are recommended for ease in the assembly of this product.
- V. The three main types of hardware used to assemble this product are : wood dowels , screws and bolts.
- V. The provided glue is to secure wood dowels in place. When first inserting dowels, locate the appropriate hole for the dowel, place a small amount of glue in the hole and insert the dowel. Wipe away excess glue immediately.




In future assembly steps when dowels are necessary to attach assembly parts together, place a small amount of glue on the end of the dowel before attaching parts together. Wipe away excess glue immediately.




VI. A Phillips head screwdriver is required for the assembly of this product.




VII. Power tools should not be used to assemble this product.




VIII. Concealed hinges are three-way adjustable.




Horizontal by screw adjustment


Secure cam bolt (B) into parts (1,8) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.




Insert wooden dowel (A) into parts (5,11,14),then secure cam bolt (B) into parts (5,11,14) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.




Insert wooden dowel (A) into parts (3,6,12),then secure cam bolt (B) into part (6) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.




Insert wooden dowel (A) into parts (7,9,13,16),then secure cam bolt (B) into parts (7,9,13,16), using screw (S) attach door stopper (N) into part (7) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.




Pick up the Ball Bearing Slides (FF) and separate the slide Runner for the following Steps. Extend the Slide Runner all the way forward, press the plastic release lever of the ball bearing Slides up and pull the Slide Runner Complete out.




Using screw (Q) attach drawer slider (FF) to parts (13,16) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.






Using cam lock(C) secure part (6) into part (5) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.












Using bolt (F) attach part (18) into part (15) with hex key (G) as per diagram.




Using cam lock(C) secure parts (8) into parts (13,16) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.















Using cam lock(H) secure part (27) into parts (25,28) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.









Using screw (L) secure plastic wedge (M) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.




Place sticker (D) cover the holes as per diagram .




Insert shelf support pin (V) into parts (3,12,13,14,16) as per diagram. Make sure you place the four shelf support pins (V) in the same level. So the shelf is not titled .Put parts (2,10) into unit as per diagram. Tilt and rest the adjustable shelf (2,10) onto the shelf support pins .




Insert wooden dowel (A) into parts (29,30,33) as per diagram.




Using screw (T) secure parts (30,33) into part (29) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.




Using screw (U) secure part (31) into parts (30,33) ,then using screw (T) secure part (31) into part (29) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.



Using screw (S) attach Europe hinge (Z) into part (31) as per diagram.




Using screw (S) attach Europe hinge (Z) into part (32) ,then using handle bolt (EE) attach handle (J) into part (32) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram. Cling the rubber pad (W) to the parts (30,33) as per diagram




Insert the assembled drawers into the unit frame, extend the Ball Bearing Slide Tracks (FF) on the pedestal Side Panel all the way forward .Then align the Slide Runners on the asembled drawers with the Slide Tracks and push the drawer carefully inside until it stops.


Note: if the drawer does not go in smoothly, please take it out and repeat the step. If you need to remove the drawer, please pull the drawer all the way out, then push the plastic release lever of the ball bearing slide up on one side and down on the other side, and then pull it completely out.




Using screw (S) attach West hinge (R) into part (17) ,then using bolt (EE) attach handle (J) into part (17) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.



Using screw (S) attach West hinge (R) into part (16) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.




Using screw (S) attach West hinge (R) into part (13) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

Put drawers into unit as per diagram.




If necessary, adjust the floor Levelers at the bottom of metal legs to level the unit.



Using screw (AA) attach plastic strap (CC) into part (1) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram


#### **WARNING**

Using screw (BB) attach plastic strap (CC) into nut (DD) to wall with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.
