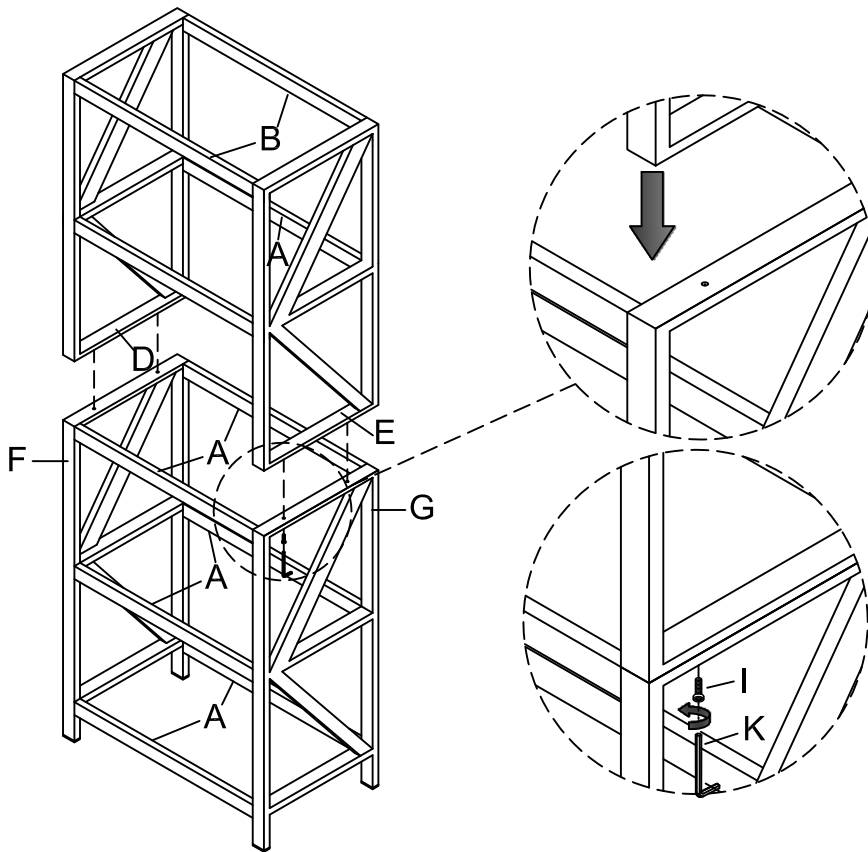
- 1 Put the upper frames (D & E) on the smooth and stable working stand. Attach the cross bars (A & B) to the upper frames (D & E). Using the bolts (H) and L-allen key (K) to tighten.



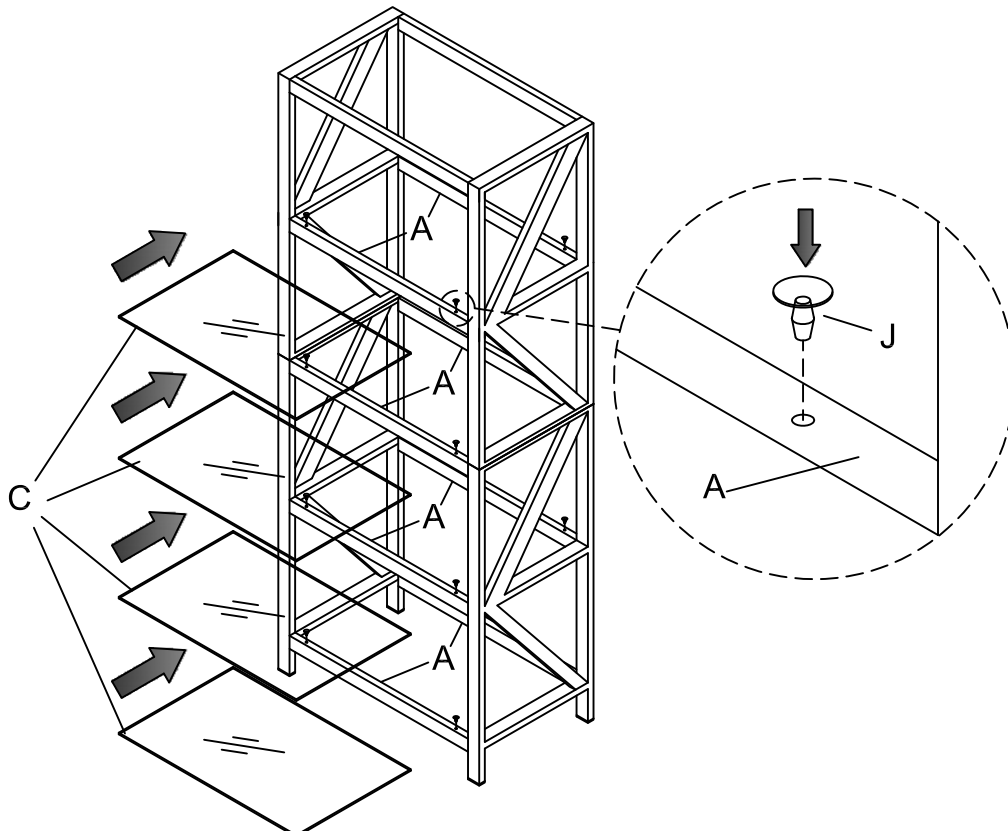
- 2 Attach the cross bars (A) to lower frames (F & G), using the bolts (H) and L-allen key (K) to tighten.



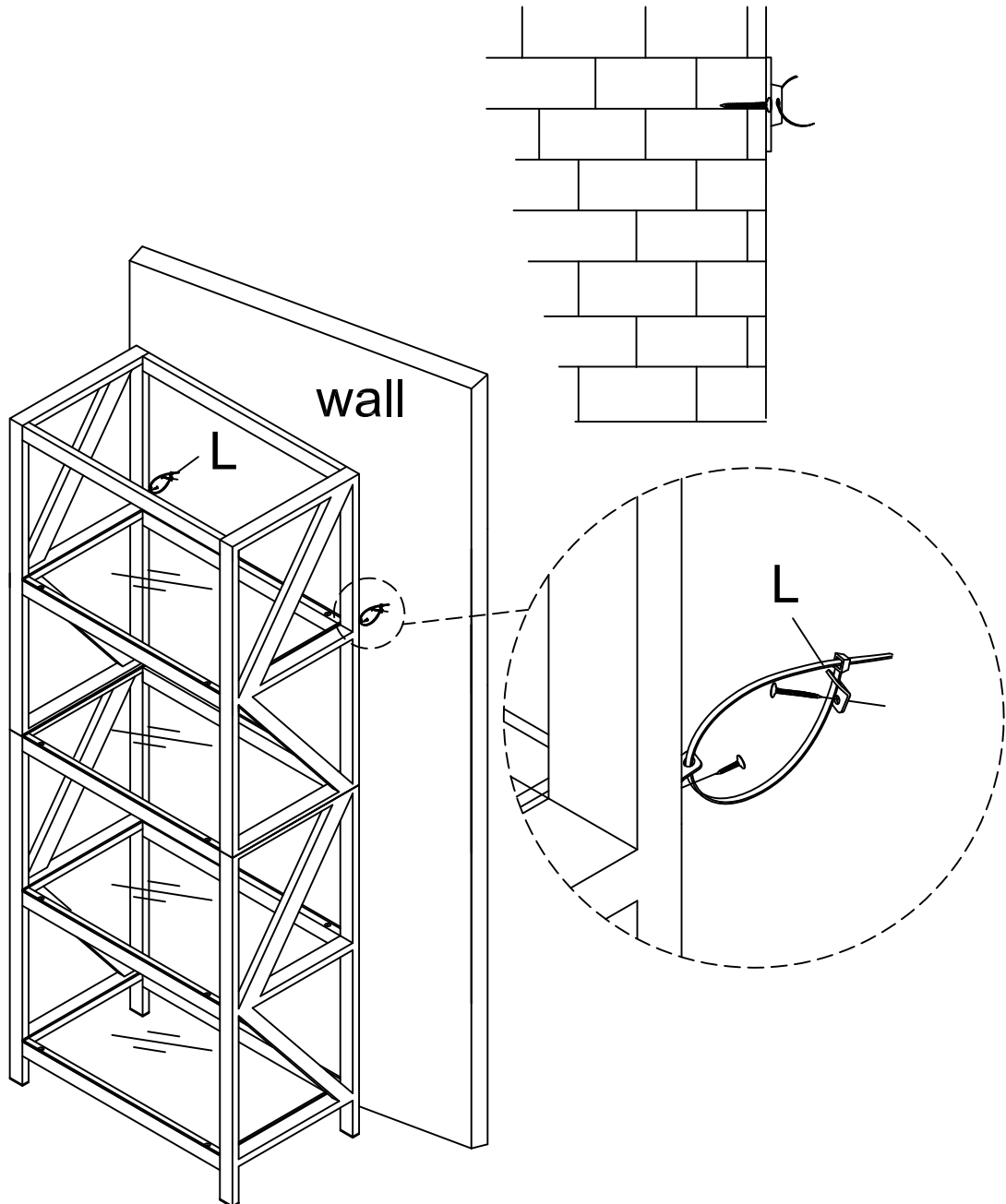
**3** Attach the upper frames (D & E) to lower frames (F & G), using the bolts (I) and L-allen key (K) to tighten.



**4** Attach the glass holder (J) to the cross bar (A), put the glass shelf (C) onto the cross bar (A).



- 5** Attach anti-tipping kit (L) to wall: Attach bracket (vertically) to wall using 2 of the screws provided. Attach bracket (horizontally) to furniture back with 2 of the screws provided. Place bracket as close to left & right of furniture back as possible in relation to wall stud and the desired position in the room. Move furniture to its final position. Thread the strap through bracket, and pull it tight.



## Cleaning & Care

Treat surface with care. Surface is resistant to scratches but is not scratch resistant. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.
