

- Do not use the changing tray if it is damaged or broken.
- Keep instructions for future use.





( x1 )




Metal plate  
( x2 )









(x1)




Metal plate  
(x2)





## **NOTES ON CARE AND MAINTENANCE:**

- . Do not scratch or chip the finish
- . Inspect the product periodically, contact Westwood Design for replacement parts or questions.
- . Do not store the product or any parts in extreme temperatures and conditions such as hot attic or a damp, cold basement. These extremes can cause a loss of structural integrity.
- . To preserve the luster of the high quality finish on your product, it is recommended to place a dolly or felt pad under any items you place on the finish.
- . Clean with a damp cloth, then a dry cloth to preserve the original luster and beauty of this fine finish.
- . Do not use abrasive chemicals.
- . Do not spray cleaners directly onto furniture.
- . Lift slightly when moving on carpeting to prevent leg breakage.
- . Use of a vaporizer near furniture will cause wood to swell and finish to peel.

- . Soulevez légèrement lors du déplacement sur la moquette pour éviter les bris de jambe.
- . Utilisation d'un vaporisateur à proximité de mobilier causera le bois à enfler et terminer à Peel.
