- **WARNING!** When child reaches a maximum weight of 30 lbs, the changing table / tray shall no longer be use.
- The changing pad used should be 16.5" (41.9cm) W x 32.5 (82.55cm) L with a maximum thickness of 1" (2.54cm).



- . Do not scratch or chip the finish
- . Inspect the product periodically, contact Westwood Design for replacement parts or questions.
- . Do not store the product or any parts in extreme temperatures and conditions such as hot attic or a damp, cold basement. These extremes can cause a loss of structural integrity.
- . To preserve the luster of the high quality finish on your product, it is recommended to place a dolly or felt pad under any items you place on the finish.
- . Clean with a damp cloth, then a dry cloth to preserve the original luster and beauty of this fine finish.
- . Do not use abrasive chemicals.
- . Do not spray cleaners directly onto furniture.
- . Lift slightly when moving on carpeting to prevent leg breakage.
- . Use of a vaporizer near furniture will cause wood to swell and finish to peel.
