## Assembly Instructions:

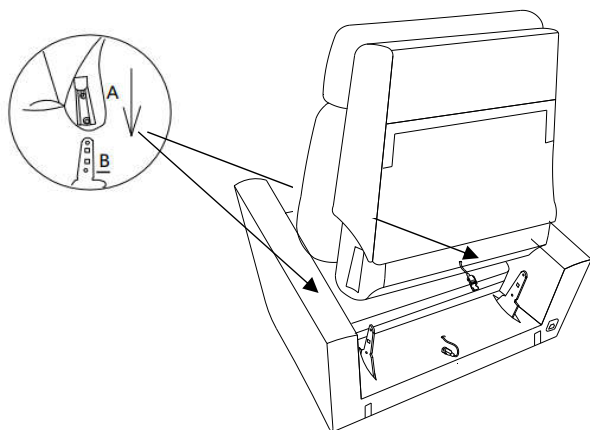
Step 1: Remove the transformer and the back from the recliner base.



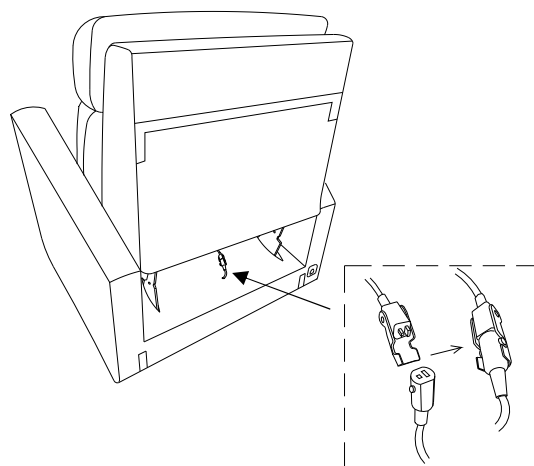
Step 2: After remove the transformer and the back from the recliner base.



Step 3: Slide the metal sleeves(A) over the metal brackets(B). Press both sides of back firmly downward until locked in place.



Step 4: Locate the power cord attached to the bottom back and connect to plug located at the rear of seat.



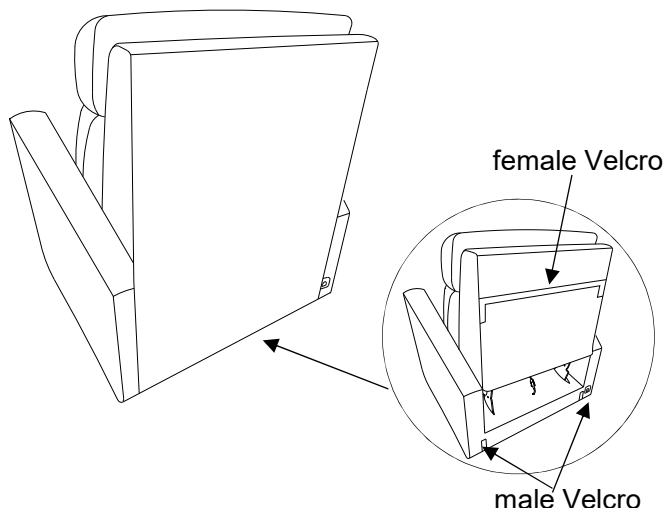

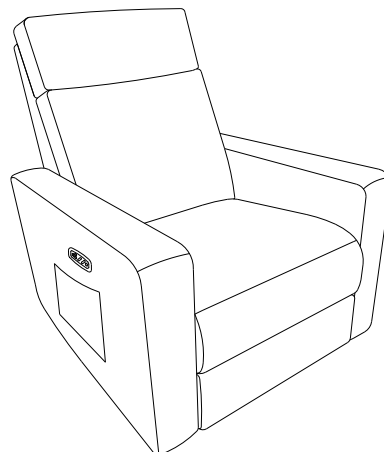

## Assembly Instructions:

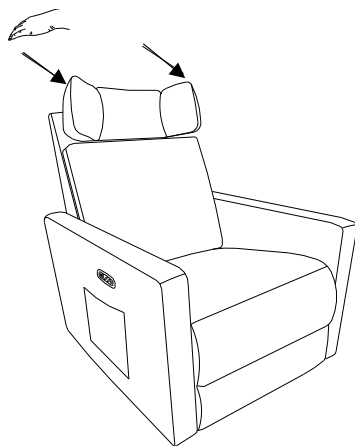
Step 5: Make sure the female Velcro on the back flap is attached to male Velcro on both side and underneath the seat base.



Step 6: Now that the recliner assembly is complete, the next step is to connect the electrical components at the base of the recliner.



Step 7: The left end and right end of headrest can be folded.

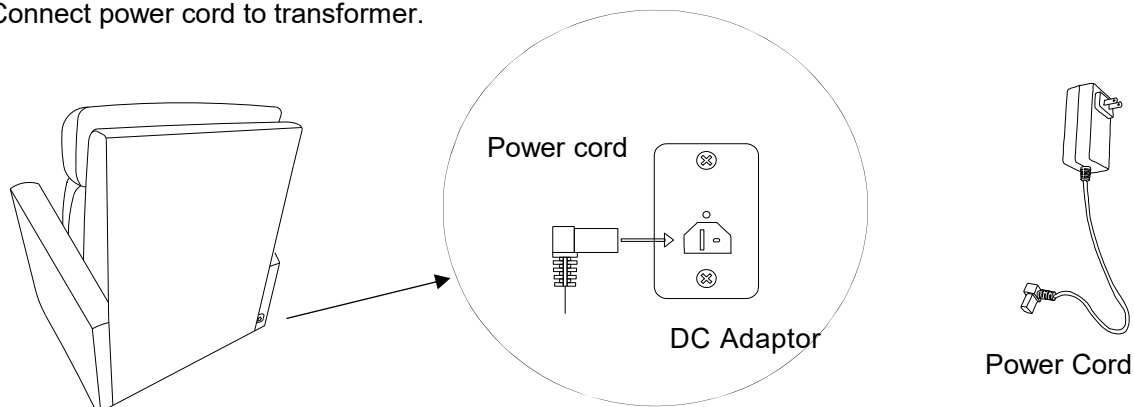


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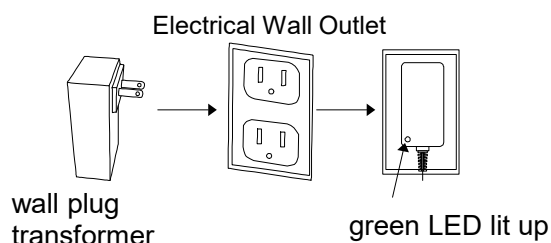

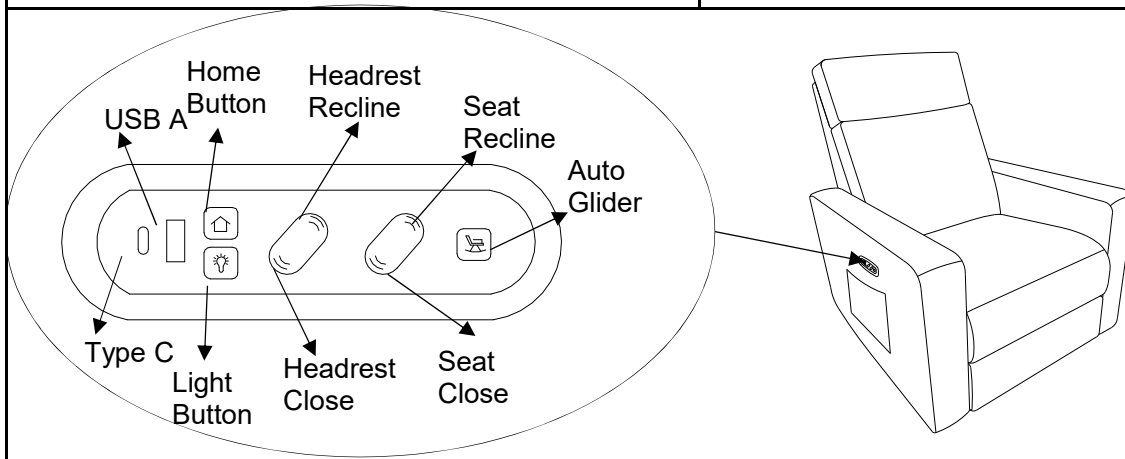
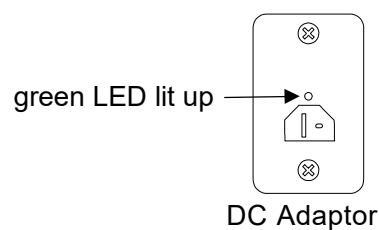
Step 8: Connect power cord to transformer.

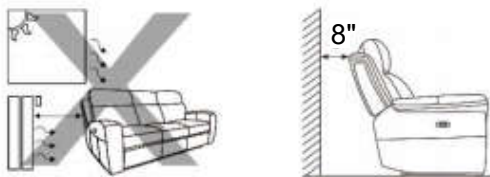

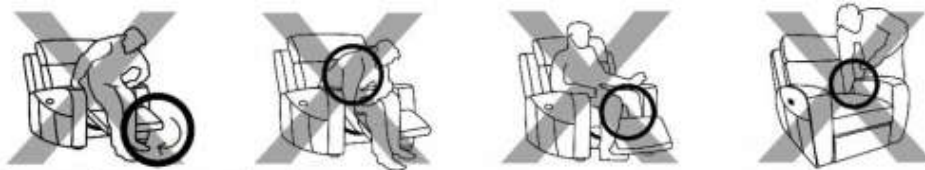
\*Maintain minimum of 8" space between the furniture backs and wall.



\*Do not leave the recliner until it is fully closed.

\*Do not reach under seat when mechanism is operating or serious injury may occur.

\*Reclining mechanism should only be operated while seated properly.



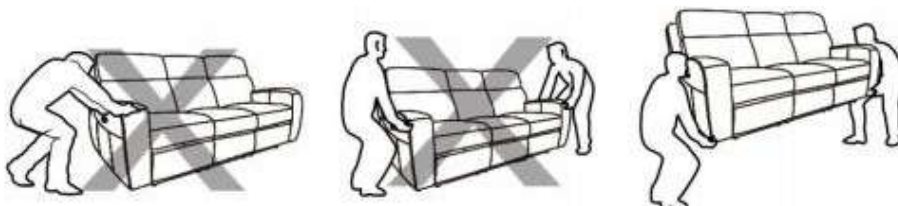
\*Do not sit on arms or backrests.

\*Do not jump or roughhouse on furniture.

\*Do not sit on the footrest when mechanism is open.

### Power Adapter Safety Instructions:

### Light Switch Safety Instructions:

1. Strictly avoid contact with liquids and do not operate with wet hands.
2. Do not press the switch repeatedly in quick succession.
3. Do not attempt to disassemble or repair it yourself.

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## CARE AND CLEANING:

\*Upholstered furniture is packaged tightly to protect it during transit. This packaging can sometimes cause creases or misshaped cushions when the furniture comes out of the packaging. These issues will correct themselves over time as the fibers of the cushions are exposed to air. However, shaping the cushions with your hands can alleviate the creases and compressed fibers more quickly.

\*Use a soft damp cloth to gently clean soiled areas and wipe clean. Do not rub.
