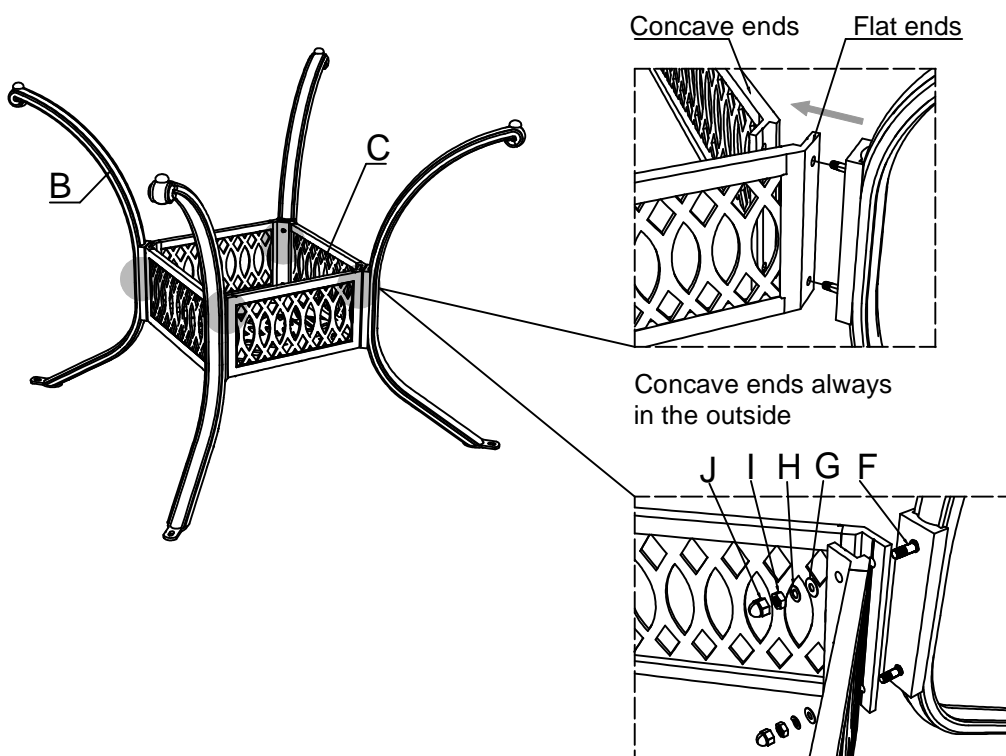
1. Place the table top (A) upside down on a non-abrasive flat surface. Align the holes in table legs (B) with the holes in the leg collecting panels (C), Loosely secure the leg collecting panels (C) to table legs (B) with the bolt (F) through flat washer (G), lock washer (H) and nut (I). Do not tighten the bolts at this point.

2. Align the holes in table legs (B) with the holes in the table top (A), Loosely secure table legs (B) to the table top (A) with the bolt (E) through flat washer (G), lock washer (H) and nut (I). Do not tighten the bolts at this point.

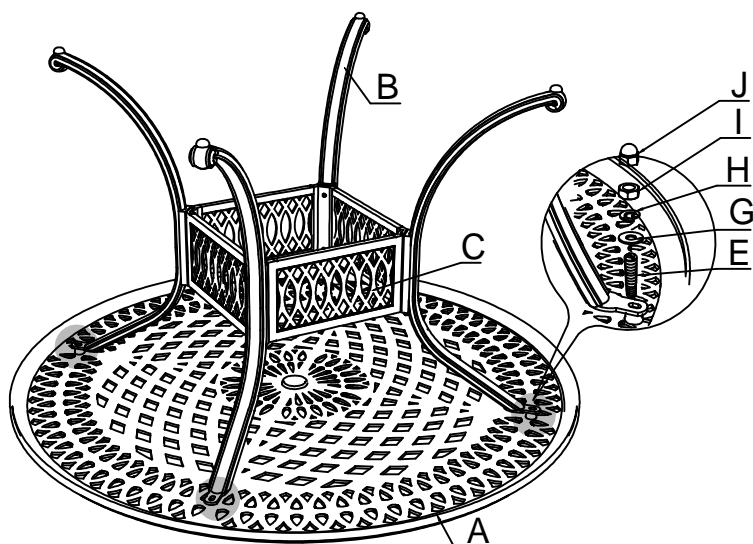
3. Check the alignment of all table legs (B), and adjust if necessary. Once the alignment is correct and all bolts are in place, Properly tighten all the bolts (E&F) and nuts (I) using wrench (K). Cover the nuts (I) with nut covers (J). With the help of another person, carefully turn the table to the upright position.

Place umbrella cover (D) on table top (A). The table is ready for your enjoyment.
