CAUTION:

Do not attempt to slide the bed once it is fully assembled. To avoid structural damage while moving your assembled bed, any mattress and bedding should be removed from the bedframe. Then the bedframe should be lifted and carried (not slid) to your desired location.

When placing furniture on non-carpeted flooring, we recommend the use of floor protection such as an area rug or furniture pads. Area rugs and padding not included with purchase.

Max Weight Limit 600lbs.


When using an adjustable base please use the legs provided with the adjustable base for maximum support.

Using zero clearance adjustable bases without legs directly on the slats is NOT recommended and will void your warranty.






Additional Tools Needed – Phillips Screwdrive.




Bed Parts are shipped inside a compartment in the back of the headboard.







Remove parts from headboard compartment










Attach (P) and (O) washers to (L) bolts. Use the (L) bolts to connect the wing (W) to the ends of the headboard (A). Tighten the (L) bolts with Allen key (Q).









Thread (J) bolts into the holes in the footboard. Do not tighten. These will be tightened in later steps.









Repeat steps to assemble right side rail.



NOTE:


Do not attempt to slide the bed once it is fully assembled. Sliding the bed could result in damage to the rails, headboard, or footboard. Assembled bed should be lifted and carried when being moved (not slid).




Repeat steps to assemble the second roll slat.

After the slat system is assembled, place the slats into the frame of the bed as shown in next page.






NOTE:

The center support leg glide sits approximately 1/4" off of the floor. The glide will usually touch the floor after a mattress is placed on the bedframe.

Do not place a mattress on bedframe until it is fully assembled and tightened. The bedframe should be located in your desired location. Sliding the bed with weight upon it can compromise the integrity of the center support legs.
